Job Description:

Walden Family Services, an established Foster/Adoption agency, is looking for a full time Program Director for our FFA program in Encino. This position will operate and manage the FFA according to agency purpose, philosophy, goals and objectives. This position will be responsible for exploring ways to increase the capacity of the FFA and provide quality Resource Family homes. A qualified candidate must be knowledgeable of CCR and the RFA approval process. This position will manage a team of social workers working within the FFA and will be responsible for providing effective leadership and guidance on a daily basis.

Qualifications:

1. The position requires that the individual be knowledgeable of, and be in compliance with the applicable laws and regulations of the client population served and the programs provided. The individual must have the ability to work effectively with others, manage personnel and program issues as they apply to the position.
2. Appropriate experience and education in a related field:

A Masters degree approved by the State Department of Social Services Community Care Licensing Regulations and:
 1. Four years full-time social work or casework employment in family or child welfare services, or
 2. Four years full-time social work or casework employment in a licensed foster family or adoption agency, and
3. Must possess valid California Driver's License and have a good driving record.
4. Fingerprint and Child Abuse Index clearances from the Department of Justice and FBI.
5. Must meet all requirements set by Community Care Licensing pertaining to the hiring of employees by a licensed community care facility.

Employee Status: Exempt

Salary Range: Beginning salary will be commensurate with education and experience.
