Job Description:

Walden Family Services, an established Foster/Adoption agency, is looking for a licensed Mental Health Clinic Supervisor for our Riverside and San Bernardino Mental Health program. This individual will provide direct clinical services for foster child/youth and non-minor dependents residing in foster homes and transitional housing. They will assist the child/youth stabilize and achieve goals that will lead to enduring change.

Qualifications:

1. Must be licensed as a LCSW, MFT, LPCC or Psychologist. Candidates must have been licensed two years or more and meet all Board of Behavioral Sciences requirements to provide supervision.
2. Must have been practicing as a therapist for a minimum of 2 out of the last 5 years
3. Experience in management of a program that serves children and families, experience with direct clinical work and play therapy.
4. Must have experience of developing behavioral treatment plans for and working with behaviorally and emotionally distributed children/youth and their caregivers.
5. Must have the ability to work effectively with others, manage personnel, program, and financial issues as they apply to the position.
6. Must have the knowledge of the applicable laws and regulations as to the population served. Prefer candidates who have experience working with children with developmental disabilities.
7. Knowledge of EPSDT documentation preferred.
8. Must possess valid California driver's license and have a good driving record.
9. Fingerprint and Child Abuse Index clearances from the Department of Justice.
10. Must meet all requirements set by Community Care Licensing pertaining to the hiring of employees by a licensed community care facility.
